

Circumnavigate the emerald coloured lake which fills a crater nestled into the side of Mount Pihanga. Enjoy picnicking and swimming in the warmer months.

Walk amongst majestic Rimu trees and birdsong. The track climbs to a viewpoint that looks out over the stunning Pureora Forest and Mount Pureora.

Rangatira Point Track Stroll through native bush on this scenic lakeside trail to Whakamoenga Point, where you will find flat volcanic rocks perfect for

picnicking and swimming.

Opepe Scenic and **Historic Reserve Walk** Explore rare mature podocarp forest, discover local Māori history and view relics from the historic Opepe township.

Timber Trail
